Student Satisfaction Survey Session 2023-24


In academic year 2023-24 feedback on curriculum aspects were collected The feedback from students on design and development of curriculum was obtained online through google form based on structured questionnaire which included 20 questions on various aspects of curriculum and suggestion for further improvement. The parameters for the feedback were analysed for five satisfaction levels 991 students fill the feedback form

The IQAC takes feedback from all the stakeholders of the institution- students and teachers at the end of each academic year on the following parameters:


Feedback Analysis Process


- 1. Teaching quality- To understand the quality of the teaching learning process adopted by the Institution and the benefits the scholars receive from such processes.
- 2. Faculty/Mentor access- To understand the accessibility of the faculty members and the quality of mentorship they provide to the scholars.
- 3. Institutional activities- To understand the satisfaction level of the stakeholders with respect to the programmes conducted by the institution.
- 4. Course curriculum and its relevance- To understand the satisfaction level of the stakeholders with respect to the course curriculum provided by the institution, whether it helps the scholars in the skill development and employability, whether there is a need to update curriculum, or introduce a new course?
- 5. Library access and facilities- To understand the satisfaction level of the stakeholders with respect to the access to the library and facilities provided such as availability of adequate number of new and revised editions of books, journals, periodicals and magazines.
- 6. Institutional facilities- To understand the benefits and satisfaction level of the stakeholders with respect to the facilities available at the institution such as the clean and hygienic canteen, washrooms, computer labs, green and eco friendly campus, and inclusive- friendly campus.
- 7. Academic activities- To understand the satisfaction level of the stakeholders and the benefits the scholars get from internships, workshops, colloquiums, study- circles, seminars, and conferences conducted by the institution.
- 8. Evaluation process- To understand the satisfaction level of the stakeholders with respect to the fair evaluation process carried out at the institution. The feedback on the above parameters were collected from all the stakeholders and analysed. The feedback report was then shared with the concerned committee members, and the faculty members to decide the further action plan.

How much of the syllabus was covered in the class? 991 responses




Out of 991 students, 56.8% students strongly agree that the course content is covered effectively [85 to 100%], 29% students agree for the course was completed 70 to 84%, 11.9% students choose for 55 to 69% and 9.8 % students agree for 30 to 54 % completion of the course while remaining views are neutral,. So, it can be concluded that there is agreement among students that the course was completed by the respective subject teachers.






How well were the teachers able to communicate? 990 responses




Was your performance in assignment discussed with you? 980 responses

The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.


974 responses


The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilities you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.

971 responses



The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow. 971 responses






What percentage of teachers used ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching. 963 responses


Efforts are made by the institute/teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.

956 responses






The teachers illustrate the concept through example and application. 970 responses




Among the 970 responses 61.5% % students strongly agreed ,26.9% students agree, 11.6% students opted for good while the rest are neutral and the

The teachers identify your strength and encourage you with providing right level of challenges. 968 responses






The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.
