


REPORT ON ANALYSIS OF STUDENTS' FEEDBACK ON CURRICULAR ASPECTS (2022-23)


Q. 1 Coverage of Course:






Out of 1039 students, 24-3% students strongly agree that the course content is covered effectively [85 to 100%], 40% students agree for the course was completed 70 to 84%, 21.9% students choose for 55 to 69% and 9.8% students agree for 30 to 54% completion of the course while remaining 4% views are neutral,. So, it can be concluded that there is agreement among students that the course was completed by the respective subject teachers

Q 2: How well did the teachers prepares for the class-



Q 3-Teachers encourages you to participate in extracurricular activity-


How well were the teachers able to communicate? 1,039 responses

Q 4, The overall quality of teaching-learning process in your institute is very good.


The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as 1,042 responses

Q 5 What percentage of teachers used ICT tools such as LCD projector What percentage of teachers used ICT tools such as LCD projector


Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers. 1,033 responses

Was your performance in assignment discussed with you? 1,031 responses



The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students


