

How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?


1,156 responses



Twenty nine percent (29%) of the students agreed that 85% to 100% of syllabus was covered in the classes, then 34.3% have the opinion that 70-84% was covered. 21.4% of the students agreed that 69% of the syllabus covered.

How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?



Out of 1148 only 30.4% of the students agreed that teachers were thoroughly prepared for the class and 48% of students opined that teachers were satisfactorily prepared and there were negligible percentage of the students whose opinion was indifferent.


How well were the teachers able to communicate?

1,149 responses




Analysis of feedback of Teacher communication skills showed that 37.2% students were in the opinion that teachers communication is “**always effective**” and 36.2% students opinion goes with “sometimes effective” and 19.7% of students were just “satisfied” with teacher’s communication.

Forty percent of students voted for “**excellent**” teaching of teachers; 28% of students opined for **very good** teaching of teachers and 23% of students have voted for **good** teaching of teachers and negligible percentage of student’s opinion were indifferent.


Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.

Thirty five percent of students voted for **always fair evaluation** by the teachers and 37% of students voted **for usually fair** evaluation and 20.3% of students voted for **sometimes fair** evaluation and rest of the students had indifferent view.

Was your performance in assignment discussed with you?



The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.



The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.



The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.



Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and program outcomes.



Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.



The teachers illustrate the concept through example and application.



The teachers identify your strength and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.



Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.



The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.



The institute/teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.



Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.



Efforts are made by the institute/teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.




What percentage of teachers used ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.

Twenty three percent agreed that **90%**, of teachers used ICT tools in their teaching ;**30.2%** said that **70-89%** of teachers used ICT tools, **24%** said that 50-69% of teachers used ICT tools. **12.4%** opined that below 29% of teachers used ICT tools and **11%** were of the opinion that **30-49%**. of teachers used ICT tools
